SEASONAL POSITIONS AT THUNDER FALLS

Seasonal employees are hired to fill a primary position on the Thunder Falls team. Because there is no “**T**” in team, it is sometimes necessary to re-assign employee positions for the team to succeed.

Cashiers: Cashiers are responsible for providing excellent customer service and are held accountable for their cash register drawer. Cashiers are needed for the food and beverage department and in the ticket booths.

Computer System Analyst: Thunder Falls’ IT person is responsible for keeping our complex computer and POS system up and running.

Cooks: Thunder Café cooks are responsible for preparing and cooking the meals that our guests love so much! Food is prepared in short preparation form according to company standards and state food codes. Cooks also wash dishes and keep workspaces clean.

Grounds Keeper: The beautiful presentation and cleanliness of the park is the responsibility of Thunder Falls' grounds keepers who plant, water, fertilize, and tend to our more than 5000 flowering plants.

Guest Service/Retail Cashier: Guest Services is located in the Retail Shop at Thunder Falls. The Guest Services/Retail Cashier is responsible for handling locker and towel rentals, guest assistance, keeping the appearance of the retail shop clean and orderly, and is held accountable for their cash register drawer.

Kitchen Prep/Clean: The responsibility of kitchen prep/clean positions is to assist cooks in preparing meals and keeping the inside and outside of the food and beverage area clean and safe.

Lifeguards: Lifeguards at Thunder Falls receive training and certification through the NASCO certification program which is conducted at the park. They are responsible for protecting the safety of guests, themselves, and co-workers and for enforcing park rules.

Maintenance: The maintenance staff at Thunder Falls is responsible for keeping the attractions and the park in safe operating conditions for our guests and employees.

Medical Aid Responder: The medical aid responder is responsible for taking over first aid services that have been initiated by a lifeguard or other staff member. The scope of work for the medical aid responder extends from basic first aid to intervention with CPR and/or AED support. The MAR is not an EMT...local emergency response is just a minute away.

Register Services: Register Services employees assist the park's bookkeeper. They are responsible for distributing and collecting cashier cash bags, delivering change to cashiers, doing cash drawer audits and exchanges, and counting cash.

Supervisor: A Thunder Falls supervisor is responsible for assisting his or her department manager to ensure that daily operations of the department run smoothly.

Water Quality Tester: The water used in our attractions must be safe, so it is the water quality tester's job to ensure that tests are continuously performed to maintain safe chemical levels in the park's water. Training for this position can lead to registration as a certified pool operator.
